





- Log into Order Time
- Right-click anywhere on the site
- Select Inspect



- Go to the refresh icon on Chrome and right-click on it
- Select Empty Cache and Hard Reload
- When it refreshes, close the inspect box with code by clicking on the X.
- Log out of Order Time and log back in

Performing an Empty Cache & Hard Reload on Firefox



It is CTRL + SHIFT + R to do the hard reload AFTER dumping the cache

Examples of a Hard Reload in multiple web browsers

Here is a quick and simple chart for each Web Browser and split by your Operating System between Windows and MacOS:



Keep in mind that where it says Reload Button, it actually means left-clicking the reload button within the browser.

 - Control + Reload Button
 - Control + F5
 - Mac
 - Command + Shift + R
 - Shift + Reload Button
- FireFox
 - Windows
 - Control + Shift + R
 - Control + F5
 - Mac
 - Command + Shift + R
 - Shift + Reload Button
- Internet Explorer
 - Control + Reload Button
 - Control + F5

- Safari
 - Option + Command + E
